



Directions to *Skoorsteenberq* Farm:

Take the N1 north and about 10km before Touwsrivier turn left onto the R46 to Ceres. This is a tar road that becomes a T Junction - left is the R46 tar road to Ceres and right is the R355 a gravel road to Calvinia. (You could also go via Ceres onto the R46 then over Theronsberg Pass until you reach this same point. If you are towing a trailer it's usually easier staying on the N1.)

Turn right here and **stay** on the R355. (Do **not** follow your GPS – only the way points) for about 70km until you see the (R354) turn off to Tankwa Karoo/Middlepos/Sutherland. Turn right here (S 32 40 55.8 E 19 42 28.6).

Drive along (R354) for about 18km and you pass a farm on the right called De Bosch. Shortly after that, there is a signboard to "Skoorsteenberq Farm & Cottages" - turn right here (S 32 33 20.8 E 19 48 41.29). This is opposite the Da Doer Padstal.

Please close all the gates and follow road.

There is "Skoorsteenberq Cottages" sign on the second gate. Turn right after going through the gate (S 32 33 31.76 E 19 50 26.27) and follow the farm road until the next gate which also has a "Skoorsteenberq Cottages" sign on it.

This gate is normally locked – so please make sure you know the code for the lock (see below). Please close and lock after you drive through (S 32 35 19.5 E 19 51 31.0). Continue on this farm road following the signs that direct you towards the Cottages. (S 32 36 23.0 E 19 57 04.3).

It is a good idea to phone me on whatsapp (+27 (0)82 455 8404) before you leave - in case of unforeseen problems like washed away roads I suggest you call this number before you get off the tar road so we can estimate when to expect you.

The Tankwa Padstal has Wi-Fi now – so a Whatsapp also works.

There is no mobile phone coverage after you get onto the gravel road off the R46.

Please do not follow Google Maps - follow the directions and use the waypoints given above only – as Google Maps will try to take you the shortest route, which will be through other farms where the gates are locked.

Remember to fill up with fuel in Worcester or Ceres because there is no fuel along this route until you get back to Worcester or Ceres.

Pop into the Tankwa Padstal on the way – meet some of the locals, and have a refreshing drink or bite to eat ☺.
